

*There are two types of green striping used in the shrub and groundcover AutoCAD map layer: diagonal and vertical. The vertical striping only appears in circles or ellipses, each of which is a single shrub.*

*The diagonal striping represents masses of herbaceous groundcover. By widely-used landscape architectural definitions, a shrub is any plant that achieves between 3' and 15' (some say 18') in height at maturity; groundcovers are plants below 3' in height. Of course, there are plants that do not conform to this necessarily broad categorization.*
